Unpaid entries will be cancelled without notice within one week of submission. A change of ownership for one or more dogs entered will be treated as a new registration at full price. Payment on the spot, on the day of the show, is not possible. Cancellation or change of entry is possible only until the closing date. If paying by bank transfer, please upload proof of payment of the show fee with the entry form. When paying for more than one dog (with the same owner or co-owners, within one registration), pay the show fees together. When paying by bank transfer pro-team, please indicate the name of the owner of the account in the Dogoffice system in the note.

Parking will be available in the parking lot directly on the premises of the řeské Budějovice Exhibition Centre for a fee.

Documents required for participation in the show: pedigree, vaccination certificate or pet passport

Titles entered for all KCHT breeds:

CAJC, CCJ, BOJ, CAC, CC, res. CAC, CCV, Winner of Special Jubilee Junior Show, Winner of Special Jubilee Show, Winner of Special Jubilee Veteran Show, BOB, BOJ, BOV and BOS

Best puppy of the breed of the Special Jubilee KCHT (awarded to a male or female with the mark very promising first - VN 1)

Best Puppy of the Breed Special Jubilee KCHT (awarded is male or female with mark very promising first - VN 1)

The best junior of the breed "BOJ" of the Special Jubilee KCHT show (the Winner of the Special Jubilee junior dog and bitch enters the ring)

Winner of the Special Jubilee KCHT Junior Show (can be awarded to male and female with V1, CAJC in the Junior class)

Winner of the Special Jubilee KCHT Dog Show (all dogs with CAC, CC will enter the ring)

Winner of Special Jubilee KCHT female (all females awarded with CAC, CC enter the ring)

Winner of Special Jubilee KCHT Veteran Show (can be awarded to both male and female with V1 in Veteran class)

Best veteran of the breed "BOV" of the KCHT Special Jubilee Show (the Winner of the Special Jubilee Veteran Show, male and female, will be entered into the ring)

BOB (both Winners of the Special Jubilee Junior Show, Winner of the Special Jubilee Dog Show, Winner of the Special Jubilee Female, both Winners of the Special Jubilee Veteran Show (V1 of the Veteran class) and both V1 of the Honorary class enter the ring for the BOB title)

BOS (participants of the BOB competition of the opposite sex than the BOB winner enter the ring)

Competitions:

- **Child and Dog** (for children aged 3 - 9 years)
- **Young Exhibitor I. category** (for children from 9 - 13 years) - only the breed judged at the show can compete
- **Young Exhibitor II. category** (for children 13 - 18 years) - only the breed judged at the show can compete
- **Best couple** (male and female of the same breed judged at the show and owned by the same owner or co-owners. Co-ownership must be proven by an entry in the pedigree card)
- **Competition for the best stud dogs** (in this competition enters the sire with at least 5 offspring, which were judged at the show. Type and quality of breeding are evaluated. The sire does not have to be judged at the show.

- **Best breeding group** (consists of at least three and no more than five individuals of the same breed, regardless of sex, from the same breeder, from the same kennel, coming from different connections (min. from two different sires or dams)
- and have been judged at the show. These animals do not have to be owned by the breeder.

Final competitions:

- **Best Puppy of the KCHT Special Jubilee Show** (best puppy of the breed enters the ring)
 - **Best Puppy of KCHT Special Jubilee Show** (best puppies of the breed enter the ring)
 - **Best Junior of KCHT Special Jubilee Show** (all those with BOJ title enter the ring)
 - **Best of the Honour Class of the KCHT Special Jubilee Show** (V1 of the Honour Class enters the ring)
 - **Best Veteran of Special Jubilee KCHT show** (all with BOV title enter the ring)
 - **The best BOS of the Special Jubilee KCHT show** (all those with the title BOS enter the ring)
 - **Best Low Legged Dog of KCHT Special Jubilee Show** (all with BOB title enter the ring)
 - **The best high legged dog of the KCHT Special Jubilee Show** (all those with the title BOB enter the ring)
 - **Best Terrier of the KCHT Special Jubilee Show** (best low-legged and best high-legged enter the ring)

Club Championship:

At the KCHT Special Jubilee Show (21.9.2024) and the KCHT Club Show (22.9.2024), if the dog obtains 2 CC or CCJ or CCV club championships, the dog will automatically receive the KCHT Club Championship. Exceptionally, non-members will be allowed to receive the club championship free of charge. The championship will be on display on the day of the show.

Classes:

The division into classes is according to the show regulations of the CMKU (they are listed on the entry form). To be included in the working class it is necessary to attach to the application a photocopy of the certificate entitling to be included in this class (certificate for dogs of hunting breeds is issued by ČMKJ, Lešanská 1176/2, 141 00 Prague 4). For inclusion in the Winner or Honorary class it is necessary to attach to the application a photocopy of the document entitling to inclusion in this class (International and National Champion, National Winner, Club Winner, Specialty Winner, European Winner, World Winner). Titles must be obtained in adult competition. The age of the dog on the day of the show is decisive for inclusion in the class, other conditions must be fulfilled on the day of application. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog. Each entry form must be accompanied by a photocopy of both sides of the pedigree card - valid for all dogs entered in the show. Without a photocopy of the pedigree card the application will not be accepted. Exhibited dogs may only be entered in one of the classes listed.

Veterinary conditions:

Dogs must be accompanied by a valid vaccination certificate or passport stating that the dog has a valid rabies vaccination at the time of relocation. Dogs from EU Member States and third

countries must comply with the conditions laid down in Regulation 998/2003 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26 May 2003. The dogs must be clinically healthy.

Protests:

Protest against the judge's decision (awards, ranking and titles) is not allowed. Protests can only be made on formal grounds (violation of show regulations and regulations). The protest must be made in writing, only during the show, at the same time as the deposit of the principal in the amount of

1.600 CZK. If the protest is not accepted, the principal will be forfeited to the organizer.

General provisions:

The exhibition is organized according to the Show Regulations of the CMKU. The organizer and the show committee are not liable for any diseases of dogs, for death or loss of dogs and are not liable for damages caused by the dog during the show. For damages caused by the dog, the exhibitor is liable. Excluded from participation in the show are dogs not listed in the catalogue (unless the fault lies with the show organiser), dogs ill, suspected of being ill, after an accident, bitches in the second half of pregnancy, lactating bitches, dogs owned by persons who have been deprived of the right to exhibit, dogs dangerous - biting and aggressive towards people and dogs. It is forbidden to alter the coat, skin or muzzle of a dog with anything that changes its texture, colour or shape. It is forbidden to groom a dog on the show grounds with any substances or devices. Only clipping, trimming, combing and brushing are permitted. It is also forbidden to tie the dog on the trimming table for longer than necessary for the trimming. Exhibitors are responsible for the welfare of the dogs. It is forbidden to expose a dog to a situation that could endanger its health or welfare, such as leaving it in a vehicle in extreme weather or cold, or treating it in an abusive manner. Violation of this regulation will result in exclusion from that and subsequent shows. Acceptance of the dog to the show will be confirmed by the Entry Sheet, which will be available for download in the exhibitor's account on Dogoffice.cz. The sale of puppies is prohibited at the show. The organizer does not take responsibility for incorrectly filled in entry form. The exhibitor (owner) agrees to publish his/her address in the catalogue, unless otherwise stated on the entry form. In the event of the show not being held due to force majeure, show fees will be refunded based on the final show calculation. Failure to attend the show for any reason is not grounds for refund of show fees. A dog from the puppy, puppy, vete-ran class cannot be considered as the first dog and honorary.
